Read the regulations of the XXII International Prize Grupo Compostela – Xunta de Galicia and submit a nomination

The Compostela Group of Universities (CGU) launches the XXII edition of the International Prize Grupo Compostela – Xunta de Galicia with the publication of the regulations on its website.

This award recognises persons and entities that committed through their labour, study, research or divulgation work to the unification of Europe and to the preservation of the cultural heritage of Camino de Santiago and its values.

Candidates can be nominated by member universities of the CGU, Xunta de Galicia, members of the Jury and official European institutions. Nominations must be submitted using the official form, available at the page of the International Prize Grupo Compostela - Xunta de Galicia, before 6th April.

The person or institution recognised with the Prize will receive a golden shell, symbol of the Compostela Group of Universities, as well as an economic amount.

As happens every year, the awarding ceremony of the Prize will be held in the frame of the General Assembly of the CGU.

Participate in the International Video Contest of the Compostela Group of Universities

The videos submitted for the competition can be made by a student or a group of students of CGU member universities, in this case one of them will be designated as the official representative. The story of the video must relate to at least one of the following topics: Camino de Santiago, values of solidarity in Higher Education, European identity and culture.

Besides, the videos must be original creations and comply with technical requirements specified in the guidelines for the VII International Video Contest.

How to submit an application?

To submit their application students should send the following documents to CGU's Secretariat: signed application form, motivation letter, video presented to the contest and a letter of support from the student home university.
