Compostela Group of Universities 3rd April 2018

Twenty universities and international institutions undertake to foster intercultural dialogue and sustainable tourism

The rectors and representatives of 19 universities and international institutions signed, on 23rd March in Santiago de Compostela, an institutional declaration with which they commit themselves to work to achieve the sustainable development goals (SDGs), protect human rights and promote tourism model that contributes to economic growth, inclusive development and environmental sustainability.

This agreement was signed in the framework of the international university forum 'The Value of Human Rights on the Camino de Santiago: harnessing the power of tourism to promote cross-cultural dialogue and achieve the sustainable development goals', which brought together more than a hundred international students in Santiago de Compostela and in which some twenty universities from 13 countries participated.
